KENNEL CLUB CODE OF ETHICS

UPDATED 2023

All breeders who register their puppies, and new owners who register ownership of their dogs with the Kennel Club, accept the jurisdiction of the Kennel Club and undertake to abide by its general Code of Ethics. Breeders/Owners:

1. Will properly house, feed, water and exercise all dogs under their care and arrange for appropriate veterinary attention if and when required.
2. Will agree without reservation that any veterinary surgeon performing an operation on any of their dogs which alters the natural conformation of the animal, or who carries out a caesarean section on a bitch, may report such operation to the Kennel Club.
3. Will agree that no healthy puppy will be culled. Puppies which may not conform to the Breed Standard should be placed in suitable homes.
4. Will abide by all aspects of the Animal Welfare Act.
5. Will not create demand for, nor supply, puppies that have been docked illegally.
6. Will agree not to breed from a dog or bitch which could be in any way harmful to the dog or to the breed.
7. Will not allow any of their dogs to roam at large or to cause a nuisance to neighbours or those carrying out official duties.
8. Will ensure that their dogs wear properly tagged collars and will be kept leashed or under effective control when away from home.
9. Will clean up after their dogs in public places or anywhere their dogs are being exhibited.
10. Will only sell dogs where there is a reasonable expectation of a happy and healthy life and will help with the re-homing of a dog if the initial circumstances change.



11. Will supply written details of all dietary requirements and give guidance concerning responsible ownership when placing dogs in a new home.
12. Will ensure that all relevant Kennel Club documents are provided to the new owner when selling or transferring a dog, and will agree, in writing, to forward any relevant documents at the earliest opportunity, if not immediately available.
13. Will not sell any dog to commercial dog wholesalers, retail pet dealers or directly or indirectly allow dogs to be given as a prize or donation in a competition of any kind. Will not sell by sale or auction Kennel Club registration certificates as stand alone items (not accompanying a dog).
14. Will not knowingly misrepresent the characteristics of the breed nor falsely advertise dogs nor mislead any person regarding the health or quality of a dog.
15. Members will, when breeding dogs, adopt as a minimum standard the principles, requirements and recommendations as embodied in the Kennel Club's Assured Breeder Scheme. It is strongly recommended that members who breed should apply to join the scheme.

LCSS – TREASURER’S REPORT

AGM 30th June 2024

Please accept my apologies for not being with you today. I was invited to judge abroad before I became involved with the Society.

The approved Accounts are presented signed by me on behalf of the Society and by our Accountants Mandair & Co.

2023 was my first full year as treasurer. Thank you to the officers and committee for your help with providing receipts for purchases throughout the year which has assisted with reconciling our expenses.

You will see that the Society made a loss in 2023 of £3,366 compared with a loss in 2022 of £6,236. The improved position in 2023 is mainly due to improved interest rates leading to increased interest on investments, reduced spending on stock, fewer donations (2022 included £1,000 to the Kennel Club for Ukraine) and a reduced depreciation of tangible fixed assets.

It is worth noting the Accountancy accrual for 2023 which will be carried forward to the 2024 Accounts but effectively increases our loss in 2023 to £4,166.

Undoubtedly the largest portion of our losses arises from the production and distribution of the Society’s yearbook which lost £2,115 in 2023, representing 63% of our total losses for the year. In 2022 the figures were £1,886 and 30% respectively. There is also an accrual of £750 for the yearbook production to be carried forward into 2024 as this is paid in arrears.



Other relevant losses are a significant fall in membership subscriptions and a £146 loss from the June open show.

I am delighted to report that a healthy profit of £843 was made at the December championship show, resulting in an overall profit for our 2023 shows of £697. A very successful raffle contributed more than 50% of this profit. Unfortunately, the 2024 championship show is likely to be adversely affected by the cost of the Woking venue which is set to rise significantly this year.

Like many other breed clubs and societies, we have been affected by widespread rising costs, including many essentials such as printing, stationery, catering supplies and postage.

In these undoubtedly difficult and uncertain times, we are incredibly fortunate to have been gifted a generous inheritance some years ago, which allows us to continue the Society's activities, despite our losses. Many breed clubs would have found this impossible and we are eternally grateful to our benefactor.

Of course, we will always strive to be profitable to help safeguard the future financial health of the Society. Accordingly, the officers and committee meet regularly to discuss improving uptake for the yearbook, driving memberships up and how to improve the profitability of our open shows. We are continuing to explore alternative show dates/days, different venues and combining with other club shows with the aim of reducing costs and maximising income.

Finally, we set up a Paypal account in 2023 which has provided another useful method of payment to help our members, particularly those overseas.



A thank you was then extended by Sarah, Vice Chairperson, to Les and Sue for all the time they give up, their continued efforts and hard work for the society.

6. Memberships Administrator's Report

169 plus 10 overseas members of these only 99 are currently paid-up members. 44 members paid in 2023 and are yet to pay in 2024. An e-mail has been sent to 10 of the members so far to enquire as whether they wish to pay their fees and continue to be members. Some of the records of contact details appear to be out of date as e-mails are sometimes bouncing back.

Suggestion that we send a committee member to shows to market the society membership to show people. Les commented that we may need permission from the show itself to market in this way. Debby also commented that she would prefer not to have to do this at shows as this is not the purpose for her attending.



Agreement that any non-paying members will be contacted enclosing a stamped address envelope and bankers order for future subscriptions.

The membership form had some errors within which has now been corrected and this unfortunately has potentially resulted in some difficulties as both the e-mail addresses on the form and website link were incorrect. It is hoped that now these details have been corrected there will be increased success in members renewing or taking out a membership.

Question from the floor? If someone hasn't paid their membership do, they still get a yearbook. This year not all members may have received a yearbook. It was confirmed that if you have not paid you will not be sent a yearbook.

Debby confirmed feedback that sometimes members purchase their membership when entering the Champ show which is at the end of the year. Debby confirms to them that this covers the year which ends in December not the one following which starts in January.

Sue Cox feedback that the payment details previously attempted had not worked and requested that the bank details on the membership form are also checked. Les H confirmed there is a designated account for membership fees which he will check are the account included on the membership paperwork.

It was confirmed that membership is due on the 1st of January each year. If membership has lapsed, then you need to



reapply and as a new member or renewing member after a lapse this needs to come to committee for approval.

Do we reconcile all the payments from shows to a membership list or do we take it as given?

The entries are not received by the membership secretary until after the show and so this is not always possible prior to the show. Damien confirmed he received the spreadsheet, including those that have purchased membership, as soon as the entry shuts online which leaves a very small window before the show to check membership details or update lists. The spreadsheet is also sent to the membership secretary at this point as well which allows a further opportunity for lists to be reviewed and updated.

Suggestion - could we make the champion show equal for all so that you separate out the two e.g. membership and show fee.

Suggestion - £20 flat fee for all at the championship show. If this went ahead it would need to be crystal clear to all society members, this is going to happen.

Les H confirmed the hire of Woking Leisure Centre is £1500 and will be going up to approx. £2000. A few other venues have been asked what they would charge if we moved and some no longer want dogs and some are yet to reply. We do have a good relationship with the Woking Leisure Centre who treat us well which also needs to be considered. The show has been moved to Sunday from 2025 to allow for free parking.





Agreement from January 2025 joint membership will increase to £15.

It was reported to those present at the AGM that Paypal was not working as expected - £12 is accepted but other membership tariffs are not being accepted which has prevented some membership payments being accepted. The committee asks that Loretta investigates this on her return.

Questions in relation to the accounts were then invited from the floor. None were received.

8. Election of A) Officers and B) Committee

Committee members were asked if anyone wished to stand down from the committee. No one did so.

James Hutton-Barber let the committee know that he has agreed to coordinate Discover Dogs and therefore he may need to step down next year and he will not be able to support LCSS at crufts.

Could we print the yearbook for the Christmas Champ show, so we no longer clash with the cocker club?

Fees for advertising are to be increased this year.



RULES OF THE LONDON COCKER SPANIEL SOCIETY

Amended in 2023

1. The name of the Society to be THE LONDON COCKER SPANIEL SOCIETY

The object of the society is for the benefit of its members and will not be classed as a trading business, so that all profits from any source, functions and/or activities of the society shall be maintained for the benefit of and further education of its members in the training, showing, breeding pertaining to Cocker Spaniels.

2. The Society shall consist of

a) A Patron, President and Vice-President, appointed by the Committee on the bases of long association or service to the breed or the society, but who will not be members of the Committee nor have voting rights when attending Committee meetings. These positions to be reviewed annually.

b) A Chairman, Vice-Chairman, Hon. Gen. Secretary, Hon. Treasurer, shall be ex officio members of the committee and who shall have voting rights. The Chairman, Hon. Gen. Secretary, and Hon Treasurer shall stand for three year term but retire individually in rotation over 3 years and be eligible for re-election. The Vice Chairman shall be appointed by the Committee at the first meeting following the AGM..

c) The Committee of not more than twelve members four of whom shall retire annually but be eligible for re-election. Five shall form a quorum at Committee meetings, this number to exclude officers. The Committee shall appoint from its number a Memberships Administrator and a Show Secretary.

d) An unlimited number of members whose names and addresses shall be recorded by the Society, and a list of members and their addresses will be available for inspection if so requested by members or by The Kennel Club Limited.

3. Applications for membership shall be subject to approval by the committee. Members shall pay an annual subscription which shall be of such amount as shall be recommended from time to time by the Committee, agreed in General Meeting, and notified to the Kennel Club. All subscriptions are renewable on 1st January each year. No member whose subscription is not fully paid up is entitled to any privileges of membership.



Members agree to abide by the Rules of the London Cocker Spaniel Society, The Kennel Club Code of Ethics and the Cocker Spaniel Breed Council Guidelines.4. The management of the society and its property shall be vested in the Committee

The Committee shall also have powers;

- a. To co-opt members onto the Committee in the event of positions becoming vacant between Annual General Meetings.
- b. The Committee may confer life membership on members who have given long, loyal and distinguished service to the Society.
- c. To make by-laws.
- d. To decide upon any matters not provided for by these rules.
But The Kennel Club shall be the final authority for interpreting the Rules of the society in all matters relating to canine or Society matters.

5. Annual General Meeting and Election of Officers and Committee.

- a. The election of Officers and Committee shall be by postal ballot in accordance with Rule 7 hereunder. One Officer shall retire annually after serving a three year term together with four members of the Committee longest in office, all of whom shall automatically stand for re-election and shall have their names entered on the Society's voting papers for re-election unless they have given notice in writing to the Society that they do not wish to stand for re-election.
- b. Nominations for the election of Officers and Committee, duly proposed and seconded and with the signed consent of the nominee, shall be made in writing and shall be sent by post to the Honorary General Secretary to arrive on or before a date to be specified in the invitation to submit nominations which will be circulated to all home members and publicised in the dog press. The result of the postal ballot for officers and Committee shall be announced at the Society Annual General Meeting.
- c. Those eligible to vote must have been fully paid up members of the Society for the proceeding and the current financial year in which the AGM is held. Those eligible to nominate or to be nominated as Officers or Committee members must be fully paid up members for two years proceeding and the current financial year in which the AGM is held.



d. Any items for inclusion on the Agenda at the AGM shall be made in writing and sent by post to the Honorary General Secretary to arrive by a date to be specified in order that such items shall be included in the Notice of Meeting as set out in 5(e)

e. The committee will decide the time and place of the AGM and give at least twenty-one day's notice of the meeting by publishing the information in Our Dogs paper and on the LCSS website. Members may request an emailed or postal copy of Agenda and Certified Accounts (when they are available). The certified accounts will be available on request to members fourteen days prior to the AGM. Ten members, excluding Officers shall form a quorum.

f. No business shall be transacted at an Annual General Meeting unless notice thereof appears on the Agenda with the exception of that which in the opinion of the chairman of the meeting is urgent.

6. A Special General Meeting may be called by the committee at any time upon twenty one (21) day's notice being given in writing; or a requisition duly signed by at least twenty-five members may be submitted to the Hon. Gen. Secretary. Subsequent upon the requisition and names of requisitioners being made available to the Committee, the Committee will call and conduct a Special General Meeting.

The Committee will invite an independent person to chair the meeting subject to majority approval by those members present at the meeting and entitled to vote. No less than 25 members to form a quorum at any Special General Meeting. The Requisition and the names of the signatories must be available at the meeting.

The notice must contain all the relevant information concerning the said Special General Meeting and business to be conducted, and no business other than that named in the notice shall be brought before a Special General Meeting.

7. Voting.

a. Those eligible to vote at any General Meeting of the Society must have been fully paid-up members of the Society for the proceeding year and the current financial year in which the meeting is held. Voting at all the Society's meetings shall be by show of hands or at the discretion of the Chairman and shall be carried by simple majority. The voting for officers and or committee members shall be by postal ballot



to all home members. Voting papers shall be forwarded to either The Kennel Club or to a nominated firm of accountants or a professional person approved by the Committee and who is not a member of The London Cocker Spaniel Society. In the event that nominations do not exceed the vacancies no ballot papers will be circulated.

b. In all matters, the Chairman shall have a casting vote (which may be cast notwithstanding that the time for voting may have ended under clause 5(b) above) and his or her ruling upon any point shall be binding at all times.

C. Each member shall be entitled to one vote but for the avoidance of doubt in the case of a partnership of not more than two persons, each of those persons shall have one vote.

8. Any member of the Committee being absent at three consecutive Committee meetings shall have his or her attention drawn to the fact and unless a reasonable excuse is forthcoming such member's seat on the Committee shall become vacant.

9. A Banking account shall be opened in the name of the Society into which all revenue of the Society shall be paid and from which withdrawals shall only be made on the signature of two of the following: the Honorary Treasurer, the Honorary General Secretary and the Chairman.

10. Any member who shall be disqualified under The Kennel Club Rule A11j (5) and/or under Kennel Club Rule A11j (9) shall ipso facto cease to be a member of the society.

If the conduct of any member shall, in the opinion of the Committee of the Society, be injurious or likely to be injurious to the character or interests of the Society, the Committee of the Society may, at a meeting the notice convening which includes as an object the consideration of the conduct of the member, determine that a Special General Meeting of the Society shall be called for purpose of passing a resolution to expel him/her. Notice of the Special General Meeting shall be sent to the accused member, giving particulars of the complaint and advising the place, date and hour of the meeting that he/she may attend and offer an explanation. If at the meeting a resolution to expel is passed by a two-thirds majority of the members present and voting, his/her name shall forthwith be erased from the list of members and he/she shall there upon cease for all



purposes to be a member of the Society, except that he/she may, within two calendar months from the date of such Meeting appeal to the Kennel Club upon and subject to such conditions as The Kennel Club may impose.

If the Society expels any member for discreditable conduct in connection with dogs, at our show the Society must report the matter in writing to the Kennel Club within seven days and supply any particulars required.

11. The financial year of the Society shall be from 1st January to 31st December. The accounts will be certified annually by a person approved by the committee and presented to the members at the Annual General Meeting. Certification of the accounts must be carried out by one qualified accountant or two unqualified individuals with accountancy experience. Any one certifying accounts should be unconnected with the Committee. At the discretion of the AGM, Honoraria may be paid in respect of services to the Society during the previous financial year.

12. The property of the Society shall be vested in the Committee, and in the event of the Society ceasing to exist a Special General Meeting shall be called to decide the disposal of any assets. A final statement of audited accounts with a record of the disposal of the property of the Society shall be forwarded to the Kennel Club within six months, and the persons named as Officers and Committee of the Society on the last return furnished to The Kennel Club will be held responsible by the Kennel Club for the proper winding up of the Society. All cups, trophies and awards that have been donated to the Society shall be deemed to be the sole property of the Society and it is only under this condition that they will be accepted. The officers and Committee shall make every effort to ensure that the wishes of the donors are respected.

13. The rules of the Society shall not be altered except at the Annual General Meeting or Special General Meeting notice of which includes details of the proposal to alter the Rules. Such alterations shall not be brought into force until The Kennel Club has been advised and has given its approval to the alterations.

14. The Society shall not join any Federation of Societies or Clubs.

15. The Officers acknowledge that during the month of January each year maintenance of title fee will be forwarded to The Kennel Club by





the Honorary General Secretary for continuance of registration and that by the 31st July in each year other returns as stipulated in The Kennel Club regulations for the Registration and Maintenance of Title of Societies and Breed Councils and the affiliation of Agricultural and Municipal Authorities, will be forwarded to the Kennel Club.

The Officers acknowledge their duty to inform The Kennel Club of any change of Secretary to the Society which may occur during the course of the year.

16. No person whilst an un-discharged bankrupt may serve on the Committee of or hold any other office or appointment within a Kennel Club Registered Society.

17 The London Cocker Spaniel Society is committed to carrying out its membership and activities in line with the 'Equality Act 2010' and will promote a culture of equality of opportunity with no one receiving less favourable treatment on the grounds of:

- Race • Colour • Nationality • Ethnic or national origin • Religion or belief • Disability • Sex • Sexual orientation • Marital status • Age • Gender reassignment • Pregnancy/maternity • Career or professional status.

The London Cocker Spaniel Society has a zero-tolerance approach to any kind of misrepresentation or discrimination towards the society, committee, members, or individuals involved in society activities based on any of the above criteria.

All participants in London Cocker Spaniel Society activities are subject to these general principles and the society reserves the right to remove society membership, subject to the expulsion process detailed within these rules, and/or participation in society events where misrepresentation or discrimination occurs.





Blueberry biscuit bones

Ingredients

- 2 eggs
- 200g almond flour
- 1 tablespoon coconut oil
- 75g blueberries
- 3-4 tablespoons coconut flour

Method

1. Preheat oven to 180°C (160°C for fan-assisted)
2. In a bowl beat the eggs and set aside.
3. Combine almond flour, coconut oil and blueberries in a bowl. Try drying or cooking the blueberries first to help with consistency.
4. Add the beaten eggs to the dough and stir well.
5. Slowly add a few tablespoons of coconut flour until an easily kneadable consistency is formed.
6. Dust your surface with coconut flour and roll out your dough (it will be quite a sticky dough).
7. Cut the dough using a bone shaped cutter and place on a well greased or lined baking tray
8. Repeat for remaining dough
9. Bake for 15 minutes or until biscuits are crisp
10. Cool and serve!

This recipe should provide around 10-12 biscuits. Store in an air-tight container and consume within a week.

Christmas tree cranberry biscuits

Ingredients

- 200g of oats, ground, or oat flour
- 2 eggs
- 2 tablespoons natural yoghurt with no added flavourings, sugar or sweeteners*
- 1 tablespoon dog-friendly peanut butter
- 50g chopped cranberries

*If your dog is unable to eat dairy make sure to use a dairy-free alternative yoghurt.

Method

1. Preheat your oven to 180°C/350F/gas mark 4 (160°C for fan-assisted ovens)
2. Mix all of the ingredients together in a large bowl until fully combined
3. Spoon the mixture into your Christmas tree moulds (or any other shape you have)
4. Place in the oven for 20 minutes
5. Remove from the oven and allow to cool before removing the biscuits from the mould

Any Colour Solid including Solid/Tan Special Puppy (3/3)

1st Ellison's Withflor Gentleman 11 month old black dog. Headed a lovely class of puppies. He has the best of heads, well balanced with a distinct stop. Dark eye with soft melting expression. Cobby in body, short coupled with a well developed forechest. Moved well once settled. BPIS

2nd Anderson Sabaloo Star Dancer 11 month black bitch. Lots to like, pretty girl with the sweetest of expression, good head and body proportions. Needs to settle on the move.

Special Novice (4/6)

1st Bindza's Laurellakes' It's a Miracle cobby black bitch of 18 months. She has the most feminine of heads, good shoulders and compact body, good straight legs standing on round, catlike feet. She has well rounded hindquarters, broad muscular thighs, and short strong hocks giving her driving power in movement.

2nd Anderson Zakova Baloo Moonshine At Sabaloo 2 year old very feminine blue bitch. Well made girl with a lovely head and expression, very moderate with no exaggerations. Again, well off for bone, moved well but not the drive of first.

Open Dog (2/3 plus 1 moved from Graduate)

1st Sheridan's Lindridge Star Quest (moved from graduate) light blue roan. A well balanced dog with lots to like. His head is well proportioned with a soft cocker expression. Short and compact, with really good bone and balanced angulation. He moved well, keeping his topline and showing great drive. Well presented. RBIS

2nd Driver's Annilann Mister Spangles at Beckaby 5 year old masculine blue roan. Well balanced head and kind eye. He has good shoulder placement and has good depth to his well balanced body. He is a sound mover keeping his topline and was shown in a good coat.

A striking 7-month-old light blue puppy who was beautifully presented. He stood squarely on well-boned legs and has a lovely head and expression. With a short and cobby build, he moved soundly and has a cheerful demeanour. I was pleased to award him Best Minor Puppy Dog, and, along with my co-judge, we also awarded him Best Minor Puppy in Show—well done and good luck for the future.

2nd Flowers Totenkopf Dutch Devotion

A 9-month-old black puppy and another beautifully presented boy with a shiny coat. He had a kind expression, dark eyes with tight rims, good overall width and well-boned. He is very short-coupled and has a good width in his hindquarters. He moved well, although he did not display quite as much confidence as the first puppy.

This 3½-year-old boy was truly outstanding. He stood square and compact, with no exaggerations in his build. He is short in the loin and has a rounded rib cage, making him solid and robust. His masculine head is free of coarseness, embodying all the qualities of a true “boy,” with dark, soulful eyes that convey a kind expression. He has a super deep chest and exhibits great bone, substance, and power throughout his physique. He was beautifully trimmed, with nothing hidden or exaggerated in his appearance. He is like a little power machine, cheerful and moving around the ring effortlessly. He ticked all my boxes! I would gladly welcome him to Scotland any day! THE BREED STANDARD

A Breed Standard is the guideline which describes the ideal characteristics, temperament and appearance of a breed and ensures that the breed is fit for function. Absolute soundness is essential. Breeders and judges should at all times be careful to avoid obvious conditions or exaggerations which would be detrimental in any way to the health, welfare or soundness of this breed. From time to time certain conditions or exaggerations may be considered to have the potential to affect dogs in some breeds adversely, and judges and breeders are requested to refer to the Kennel Club website for details of any such current issues (www.the-kennel-club.org.uk/services/public/breeds/watch) If a feature or quality is desirable it should be present in the right measure. However if a dog possesses a feature, characteristic or colour described as undesirable or highly undesirable it is strongly recommended that it should not be rewarded in the show ring.

General Appearance

Merry, sturdy, sporting; well balanced; compact; measuring approximately same from withers to ground as from withers to root of tail.

Characteristics

Merry nature with ever-wagging tail shows a typical bustling movement, particularly when following scent, fearless of heavy cover.

Temperament

Gentle and affectionate, yet full of life and exuberance.

Head and Skull

Square muzzle, with distinct stop set midway between tip of nose and occiput. Skull well developed, cleanly chiselled, neither too fine nor too coarse. Cheek bones not prominent. Nose sufficiently wide for acute scenting power.

Eyes

Full, but not prominent. Dark brown or brown, never light, but in the case of liver, liver roan and liver and white, dark hazel to harmonise with coat; with expression of intelligence and gentleness but wide awake, bright and merry; rims tight.

Ears

Lobular, set low on a level with eyes. Fine leathers extending to nose tip. Well clothed with long, straight silky hair.

Mouth

Jaws strong with a perfect, regular and complete scissor bite, i.e. upper teeth closely overlapping lower teeth and set square to the jaws.

Neck

Moderate in length, muscular. Set neatly into fine sloping shoulders. Clean throat.

Forequarters

Shoulders sloping and fine. Legs well boned, straight, sufficiently short for concentrated power. Not too short to interfere with tremendous exertions expected from this grand, sporting dog.

Body

Strong, compact. Chest well developed and brisket deep; neither too wide nor too narrow in front. Ribs well sprung. Loin short, wide with firm, level topline gently sloping downwards to tail from end of loin to set on of tail.

Hindquarters

Wide, well rounded, very muscular. Legs well boned, good bend of stifle, short below hock allowing for plenty of drive.



Feet

Firm, thickly padded, cat-like.

Tail

Set on slightly lower than line of back. Must be merry in action and carried level, never cocked up. Previously customarily docked.

Docked: Never too short to hide, nor too long to interfere with, the incessant merry action when working.

Undocked: Slightly curved, of moderate length, proportionate to size of body giving an overall balanced appearance; ideally not reaching below the hock. Strong at the root and tapering to a fine tip; well feathered in keeping with the coat. Lively in action, carried on a plane not higher than level of back and never so low as to indicate timidity.

Gait/Movement

True through action with great drive covering ground well.

Coat

Flat, silky in texture, never wiry or wavy, not too profuse and never curly. Well feathered forelegs, body and hindlegs above hocks.

Colour

Solid Colours

Black; red; golden; liver (chocolate); black and tan; liver and tan; No white allowed except a small amount on chest.

Particolours Bicolours

Black and white; orange and white; liver & white; lemon and white; All with or without ticking

Tricolours

Black, white and tan; liver, white and tan.

Roans

Blue roan; orange roan; lemon roan; liver roan; blue roan and tan; liver roan and tan.

Any colour or marking other than the above is undesirable.

Size

Height approximately: dogs: 39-41 cms (15 1/2-16 ins); bitches: 38-39 cms (15-15 1/2 ins).

Weight approximately: 13-14.5 kgs (28-32 lbs).

Faults

Any departure from the foregoing points should be considered a fault and the seriousness with which the fault should be regarded should be in exact proportion to its degree and its effect upon the health and welfare of the dog, and on the dog's ability to perform its traditional work.

Note

Male animals should have two apparently normal testicles fully descended into the scrotum.
