Sp Novice (2, 1a) Whiteley's Glowhill Gallivant, 15 month old b/r, lovely head and eye, correct earset and dentition, moderate length of neck flowing into well placed shoulders, short coupled, straight hocks, moved out well with ever wagging tail. Sorry he had to leave early due to unforeseen circumstances.

Sp Grad (6) 1. Collins's Bartonholm Prince of Tides at Candyke JW, masculine head but certainly not overdone, dark eyes and lovely melting expression, lovely length of neck and well placed shoulders, good forechest, tight elbows, neat feet, good firm rear, moved well using his tail, one to watch! 2. Sheridan's Oktumi Mischief Maker, 17 month b/r, nice head and eye, shorter in neck than 1 and also longer in body, nice front, good upper arm, neat feet, correct tail set, lovely straight hocks, moved well with ever wagging tail, A1 presentaion. 3. Bevis & Norie-Miller's Popocatepeti Tomfoolery.

Sp Open (3) 1. Whitehead's Casanova Of La Vie Magnifique (ImpHun), striking o/w, masculine head but not overdone, lovely pigment, moderate neck flowing into well placed shoulders, super forechest and upperarm, tight elbows and well sprung ribs, short in loin, lovely width of thigh and correct bend of stifle, straight well let down hocks moved with drive and ever wagging tail, trimmed to perfection, pleased to award him the CC, his 3rd , a very worthy Sh Ch (subject to KC approval), RBIS, well done. 2. Driver's Annilann Mister Spangles at Beckaby JW, b/r, lovely dark eyes and expression, correct earset, shorter in neck and longer cast than 1, tight elbows, neat feet, good bend of stifle, correct tailset, moved out well, happy mover, presentation A1. 3. White's Merrysprings Magic Star.

Sp Grad (2, 1a) Anderson & Foster's Zakova Sundance Kyd At Sabaloo, 15 month old blk, masculine head with lovely dark eyes, melting expression, moderate neck, correct shoulder placement, super forechest, tight elbows, lovely spring of rib, short in loin, well let down hocks, moved well with an ever wagging tail, all in all a lovely honest dog, pleased to hear that his other IS placing in Under Graduate gave him the points needed for his JW, massive well done from me, well deserved!

Sp Open (3) 1. Roberts & Smith's Rayol The Editor, lovely blk with dark eyes and masculine head, carrying a bit too much weight over his shoulders on the day, super tight elbows and a lovely big ribcage, neat feet, well rounded rear with lovely bend of stifle, moved well fore and aft, in super coat and condition. 2. Robertson's Sh Ch Kastrian Affection JW, another lovely blk, smaller made than 1, lovely neck and shoulders, short in loin, correct tailset, neat feet, moved well, very well presented. 3. Wiggins's Sh Ch Snowgate Onyer Bike To Scapafeld JW.

Pearce-Gudger's Sh Ch Cachel Prince Charming Of Pearkim JW, looking fantastic, I've judged him before and gave him his 3rd CC, lovely head and dark eye, correct dentition, super neck and shoulder placement, lovely upperarm, nice tight elbows, short in loin, neat cat light feet, well rounded rear with good width of thigh, moved well with super gait, considered for top honours, a very worthy Sh Ch, BVD. 2. Cassidy's Manchela Hugo Boss JW ShCM ShCEX OSW, another lovely dog b/r with dark eyes, correct dentition, lovely forechest, big ribs, strong powerful well boned legs, neat feet, super gait on the move, lovely topline, well presented. 3. Cox's Sh Ch Gardenstone Pale Rider To Suvern JW.

MP (6) 1. Stokes-Harrell's Riondel The Showman, 6 month old b/r and what a lovely wee showman he is, caught my eye on entering the ring

and didn't disappoint when I went over him, lovely kind expression, dark eyes and super pigment, lovely forechest, straight upperarm, nice tight elbows, short and cobby with a lovely big ribcage, great width of thigh, moved well with attitude, definitely one to watch, hopefully he'll have a bright future. 2. Young's Canyon Black Caviar, 7 month blk, lovely head for his age, nice dark eyes and expression, moderate neck, longer cast than 1, good shoulder placement, nice width of thigh, moved well, All presentation. 3. Thomas's Claramand Foolin Around.

Puppy (2, 1a) Barrington's Luciena Real Aspiration 10 months old blk/t, lovely dark eyes, correct dentition, super clean tan markings, nice width of thigh, hard to assess as he gave his handler a hard time on the table and on the move, he's young give him time.

Junior (6) Bayliss's Shirepark Sir Francis Drake By Wilanorah, 12 months old b/r, I loved this boy's head, masculine without a doubt but certainly not overdone, lovely dark pigment, correct scissor bite, super length of neck and well placed shoulders, lovely tight elbows, straight upperarm, neat feet, short coupled, nice width of thigh, straight well let down hocks, moved with drive and purpose using his tail, well presented, considered for top honours, hopefully his day will come, pleased to hear this placing gave him the points he needed for his JW, well done. 2. Sheridan's Oktumi Mischief Maker. 3. Anderson & Foster's Zakova Sundance Kyd At Sabaloo.

Yearling (4, 2a) Barnes's Challowdown Smoking Hot, 21 month old o/r, really liked this boy, lovely masculine head, dark eye and pigment, correct length of neck flowing into well placed shoulders, nice forechest, tight elbows, lovely spring of rib, short in loin, correct tailset, lovely short hocks, gave his handler a hard time on the move but moved well when settled, would benefit from less hair on his rear, will watch this young man with interest. 2. Rofe's Villaspaniol Gold Flash, 23 month old golden, lovely dark eyes, correct dentition, slightly upright in shoulder, not the forechest or ribcage of 1, neat feet, movement was a bit erratic on the day, presented well.

Maiden (5 1a) Whiteley's Glowhill Gallivant. 2. Bond's Olibond Not A Bother, 13 month old b/r, lovely dark tight eyes, correct dentition, nice length of neck, good shoulder placement, correct tailset, neat well padded feet, he wasn't happy today on the table nor on the move, hopefully he will gain his confidence with time, well presented. 3. Pearce-Gudger's Sunset D'Hell Storm For Pearkim (Imp Fra).

Tyro (4 1a) 1. Sheridan's Oktumi Mischief Maker. 2. Provost's Troubles In Paradise U're Moriarty, 14 month old o/r, lovely dark eyes, masculine head but not overdone, good pigment, moderate length of neck, super

forechest, nice tight elbows, slightly longer cast, excellent width of thigh, lovely neat catlike feet, moved well fore and aft with ever wagging tail, lots to like about this young man.3. Wright's La Scales Berlin With Chazbaz (ImpHun).

Birkenshaw's Gilear Midnight Dream, lovely b/r unfortunate to meet number 1 in such good form, lots to like about this boy too, he has a lovely kind eye, soft expression, masculine head but not overdone, excels in neck, would like a bit more in front, short coupled, nice bend of stifle, short straight hocks, moved well for and aft, well presented. 3. Roberts & Smith's Rayol Look Hu's Talkin, light blue, what a lovely lad, super tight dark eyes, masculine head, correct length of neck and well placed shoulders, nice forechest, lovely tight elbows, neat cat like feet, short coupled, excellent width of thigh, well let down hocks, moved well reaching out, super gait and lovely wagging tail, presentation Al. 2. Van Guyse-Apers's U Believe In Me Aster Bears, another lovely blue boy, nice dark tight rimmed eyes, square muzzle, moderate neck, tight elbows, big forechest, well rounded ribcage, short in loin, good width of thigh, moved well with attitude, happy boy, very well presented. 3. Brennan's Covenant Celtic Prince Of Kerrijoy.

Open (4 1a) 1. Keeley's Oakbeach Dare To Dream Big With Alhambrian (Imp Swe), lovely blue roan who I have admired before, super dark tight rimmed eyes, masculine head without coarseness, moderate neck and well placed shoulders, lovely tight elbows, straight upperarm, good width at front and rear, neat cat like feet, excellent width of thigh, correct tail set, moved well with super reach and drive, happy mover, trimmed to perfection, considered for top honours. 2. Maguire & Sugden's Bencleuch Before The Storm, another nice b/r, lovely dark tight eyes, not the head

of 1, nice length of neck, would like a bit more in front, good tight elbows, neat feet, super width of thigh, well bent stifles, lovely straight hocks, if being hyper critical, would like more hair left on at his rear JMHO, he moved well fore and aft, presented well.
