1. Zakova Baloo Moonshine at Sabaloo. This blue was 3rd in Special Novice and moving more settled and freely, a well made nice girl.

1. Annilann Miss Scary Poppins. One of those bitches when being examined really draws your attention positively. I really liked this one, lovely balanced body properties with lots to admire.
2. Stobytil Bootylicious. A very nice blue girl with good legs and feet, overall very good in width and depth, she went very well.

Undergraduate

1. Glowhill Chiquitita. Some Cocker quality here, good balance moving and standing, good flow from neck into body, clearly a good one that in full coat will trouble the best.

Post Graduate

Two very nice blacks dominated this class in their full coats and condition.

Limit

A nice class as one would expect with the merest subtleties separating them, however 1st was excellent.

1. Lararth Midnight Blue. Down to my last four and so close to the C.C. An unexaggerated blue girl who was short and deep, in excellent coat and condition. Lovely work in her head, clean all through, really for me an excellent bitch.
2. Sheigra Simply A Star JW. Cocker movement won this girl her place in this strong class. No weakness anywhere in her construction or movement, a top notch black bitch of quality.
3. Annilann Miss Sweetheart at Weyhill.

Open Bitch

1 and R.C.C. Oktumi Opalescence. There is nothing more original I could write about his charming blue girl. I liked all about her from nose to tail and when settled, displayed near perfect movement, an exceptional one in type and shape.
